የኢትዮጵያ እና ኬንያ የንግድ ስምምነትን ወደ ተግባር ለማስገባት ዝግጅት እየተደረገ መሆኑን የንግድና ቀጣናዊ ትስስር ሚኒስቴር ገለጹ። ሁለቱ ሀገራት የተቀላጠፈ የጠረፍ ንግድ ማዕቀፍ ላይ በሦስት ዙር ያደረጉትን ድርድር በመቋቋት ባለፈው ወር ስምምነት መፈራረማቸው ይታወቃል። ስምምነቱ በድንበር አካባቢ የሚገኙ ዜጎች ከመሃል ሀገር በቀላሉ ማግኘት የማይችሏቸውን ምርቶች በጠረፍ ንግድ እንዲያገኙ ለማስቻል ያለመ መሆኑን የንግድና ቀጣናዊ ትስስር ሚኒስቴር የኮሙኒኬሽን ጉዳዮች ዳይሬክተር ወንድሙ ፍላቴ ገልጸዋል።

ዳይሬክተሩ ለፋና ዲጂታል እንደገለጹት፣ በስምምነቱ መሰረት የጠረፍ ንግድ ከኢትዮጵያ ድንበር በ50 ኪሎ ሜትር እንዲሁም ከኬንያ ድንበር በጠረፍ አካባቢ ንግድ የሚቀርቡ ምርቶችን በተመለከተ የገበያ ፍላጎትና ለአካባቢው ማህበረሰብ አስፈላጊ የተባሉ ምርቶችን በጥናት በመለየት በስምምነቱ መካተቱን ገልጸዋል። በ100 ኪሎ ሜትር ርቀት ውስጥ ያሉ አካባቢዎችን ይሸፍናል። ከቀም እንስሳትና የእንስሳት ተዋጽኦ፣ አትክልትና ፍራፍሬ፣ አዝዕርት፣ የምግብ ዘይት፣ መጠጦች፣ ቆዳና የቆዳ ውጤቶች፣ አልባሳትና ጫማዎች፣ የቤት መገልገያና የመዋቢያ ቁሳቁሶች ውጪ ሌሎች ምርቶችን መገበያየት እንደማይቻል አስረድተዋል።

5. Foreign Banks to Make it to Ethiopia's Financial Market by 2025: NBE Governor

National Bank of Ethiopia Governor Mamo Mihretu says foreign banks will commence operations in the Ethiopian financial sector before the year is out.

Speaking at the Ethiopian Finance Forum held mid week, the governor highlighted the government's decision to open up the financial sector to foreign banks as one of its key recent policy shifts.

Mamo then announced that the necessary groundwork has already been laid for the expected entrance into the Ethiopian financial sector of the foreign banks.

Stopping short of naming the banks on their ways to Ethiopian financial turf, Mamo emphasized that integrating foreign financial institutions remains one of the NBE's top priorities.

During his presentation Mamo has disclosed that certain guidelines previously considered "obstacles" to the entry of foreign banks will be revised sooner than the timeline initially indicated for their entry.

6. Africa CEO Forum: What If Africa Set the Rules? [Business Africa]

Africa news; May 17/2025

Held on May 12–13, 2025, in Abidjan, the 12th edition of the Africa CEO Forum brought together over 2,800 leaders, including six African heads of state, to deliberate on the continent's development trajectory. Key discussions centered on energy strategies, technological advancements, and infrastructure development.

At the Africa CEO Forum 2025, nuclear energy emerged as a focal point in discussions about Africa's energy future. **Loyiso Tyabashe**, CEO of South Africa's Nuclear Energy Corporation (Necsa), emphasized the necessity of integrating nuclear power with renewable sources to ensure a stable and affordable energy supply.

"Nuclear provides baseload power essential for industrialization," Tyabashe stated. He highlighted the cost-effectiveness of nuclear energy, citing South Africa's experience with its two nuclear units in Cape Town as among the cheapest electricity sources. Moreover, he underscored the environmental responsibility of nuclear power in reducing carbon emissions.

The forum's discussions reflected a growing consensus on the role of nuclear energy in Africa's sustainable development

7. IGAD Hosts 3rd Regional Water Forum to Foster Sustainable Groundwater Cooperation

The Intergovernmental Authority on Development (IGAD) has officially opened the 3rd IGAD Water Forum in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

The Forum is organized under the theme: "Building a Platform for Sustainable Regional Groundwater Cooperation."

The three-day event, taking place from 19 to 21 May 2025, convenes representatives from IGAD Member States, international organizations, technical experts, and development partners to strengthen regional efforts in groundwater governance.

Groundwater resources are crucial to the Horn of Africa's socio-economic development and environmental sustainability.

With increasing demands driven by climate variability, urbanization, and population growth, managing shared groundwater aquifers—such as the Dawa, Shabelle, and Northern Basement systems—requires coordinated and innovative solutions across national borders.

8. PM Says AI Can Drive Inclusive Prosperity in Africa, Help Realize Goals of Agenda 2063

Africa is entering a new era where homegrown Artificial Intelligence (AI) can drive inclusive prosperity and help realize the goals of Agenda 2063, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed noted.

Speaking at the AI for Africa program organized as part of the Ethiopian Tech Expo 2025, the premier emphasized the importance of AI for Africa's transformation by addressing pressing challenges the continent is confronting.

According to him, AI is no longer a distant dream but the engine of transformation across sectors, geographies and societies.

"Many of Africa's pressing challenges, such as agricultural inefficiencies, health care gaps, poor education, youth unemployment, regular migration and inefficient public service can be addressed through high powered solutions."

Hence, the PM stressed that Africa must lead with bold inclusive policies, agile regulation and accelerated skill development emphasizing the need for Africa to claim ownership of its data, the foundation of artificial intelligence.

"Data sovereignty is not just technical. It affirms our right to shape our own future by investing in local data infrastructure, promoting ethical data use, and setting standards aligned with our values so as reduce dependency on external technologies, and unlock AI's full potential for Africa."

Elaborating about Ethiopia's endeavors in the development of the sector, Abiy stated that the country has made a bold decision five years ago.

"We recognized that artificial Intelligence is more than a tool. It is a transformative force. We made a deliberate choice not to remain passive consumers of imported innovation, but to become active contributors, leveraging AI to address challenges grounded in our own realities."
