## 1. ባለፉት 11 ወራት ከወጪ ንግድ ከ7 ነጥብ 21 ቢሊዮን ዶላር በላይ ገቢ ተገኘ

በበጀት አመቱ 11 ወራት ከ7 ነጥብ 21 ቢሊዮን ዶላር በላይ ገቢ ከወጪ ንግድ መገኘቱን የንግድና ቀጠናዊ ትስስር ሚኒስቴር አስታወቀ።

የንግድና ቀጠናዊ ትስስር ሚኒስትር ካላሁን ጎሬ (ዶ/ር) እንደተናገሩት በበጀት አመቱ በሀገሪቱ የወጪ ንግድ ታሪክ ከፍተኛ የሆነ ገቢ ተገኝቷል።

ከጠቅላላ የወጪ ንግድ 4 ነጥብ 59 ቢሊዮን ዶላር ለማግኘት ታቅዶ ወደ ስራ መገባቱን አስታውሰው በአፈጻጸም ከእቅድ በላይ 7 ነጥብ 21 ቢሊዮን ዶላር ገቢ መገኘቱን ገልጸዋል።

በበጀት አመቱ መጨረሻ ከ 8 ቢሊዮን ዶላር በላይ ገቢ ይገኛል ተብሎ እንደሚጠበቅም ጠቁመዋል።

በበጀት አመቱ 11 ወራት ከወጪ ንግድ የተገኘው ገቢ ከ2016 በጀት አመት ጋር ሲነጻጸር ከ 3 ነጥብ 96 ቢሊዮን ዶላር በላይ ጭማሪ ማሳየቱንም ጠቅሰዋል።

### ESX chief calls on diaspora to invest

The government is preparing to roll out the sale of bonds through the newly formed Ethiopian Securities Exchange (ESX) in a move aimed at deepening domestic debt financing and attracting foreign investment.

The initiative, scheduled to begin in July 2025, marks a significant shift in short-term treasury instruments diversifications. The announcement was made by Tilahun Kassahun (PhD), CEO of the Exchange, during a high-level forum organized on June 10, 2025, under the theme *Fostering Renewed Connections Between the Economy and Foreign Affairs Sectors: Towards an Enhanced Economic Diplomacy* by the Institute of Foreign Affairs.

## 6. Austerity over Ambition: Experts Slam Ethiopia's New Budget as IMF-Driven Burden

The government's new 1.93 trillion Birr federal budget—its first since signing a USD 3.4 billion agreement with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank last May—is drawing sharp criticism from economists and financial experts who warn it reflects foreign dictates more than local priorities.

Economic analyst Kebour Ghenna describes the budget as “an economic obituary for the public sector,” pointing to its lack of new infrastructure projects, domestic manufacturing stimulus, income tax relief, or meaningful support for the poor.

## 7. Existing Global Trade Policies Validate Urgency of Fast-tracking AfCFTA: Afreximbank

President of African Export–Import Bank (Afreximbank), Professor Benedict Oramah addressed the implications of shifting global trade policies, including the reintroduction of reciprocal tariffs by the U.S., noting that such developments further validate the urgency of fast-tracking the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA).

In a powerful exchange moderated by Michael Rheinegger of the Swiss-African Business Circle on the sidelines of the Swiss-Africa Business Day, Afreximbank President joined WTO Director-General Dr. Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala for an insightful conversation on Africa's evolving trade landscape, policy shifts, and the continent's evolving partnerships.

Prof. Oramah emphasized that the current global trade issues highlight the critical need to expedite the AfCFTA process.

With intra-African trade still accounting for less than 18 percent of total trade, the AfCFTA provides a viable mechanism to build resilient value chains, stimulate industrial growth, and reduce reliance on external markets.

## 8. China-Africa Economic and Trade Expo: Forging a new area of partnership

The Permanent Exhibition Hall of the China-Africa Economic and Trade Expo is located in the China-Africa Economic and Trade Cooperation, Promotion, and Innovation Demonstration Park in the Yuhua Block, Changsha Area, China (Hunan) Pilot Free Trade Zone.

It is a public service platform for the exhibition and sales of African products and trade with Africa. As a major project of Hunan Province, it aims to create a perpetual China-Africa Economic and Trade Expo.

The first session of China-Africa Economic and Trade Expo (CAETE) took place in Changsha, Hunan, in June 2019. With the theme of “Win-Win Cooperation for closer China-Africa Economic and Trade Partnership”, guided by the “Eight Major Initiatives”, it focused on key areas such as trade, agriculture, investment, financing, cooperation parks and infrastructure. Over 30 activities have been conducted, including thematic seminars, professional forums, trade talks, exhibitions, and field visits, according to a source.

Representatives from 53 African countries that have diplomatic relations with China, 30 ministries/commissions under the central government, 12-plus international organizations including the African Union, and 30 provinces/municipalities/autonomous regions in China participated in the expo and exhibition
