በ2017 በጀት ዓመት ወደ ውጭ ከተላከ የቡና ምርት 2 ነጥብ 65 ቢሊዮን የአሜሪካን ዶላር ገቢ መገኘቱን የኢትዮጵያ ቡናና ሻይ ባለሥልጣን አስታወቀ።

ከቡና የሚገኘውን ኢኮኖሚያዊ ጥቅም ለማሳደግ በተከናወኑ የለውጥ ተግባራት ተጨባጭ ውጤት መመዘገቡንም ባለሥልጣኑ ገልጿል።

የባለሥልጣኑ ዋና ዳይሬክተር አዳኛ ደበላ (ዶ/ር) በሰጡት ማብራሪያ በ2017 በጀት ዓመት 326 ሺህ ቶን ቡና ወደ ውጭ በመላክ 2 ቢሊዮን የአሜሪካን ዶላር ገቢ ለማግኘት በእቅድ ተይዞ ሲሰራ መቆየቱን አንስተዋል።

በበጀት ዓመቱ 470 ሺህ ቶን የሚጠጋ ምርት ወደ ውጭ መላኩን የገለጹት ዋና ዳይሬክተሩ በዚህም 2 ነጥብ 65 ቢሊዮን የአሜሪካን ዶላር ገቢ ተገኝቷል ብለዋል።

የተገኘው ገቢ ኢትዮጵያን ከአፍሪካ ቀዳሚ የሚያደርጋት መሆኑን ጠቅሰው በዓለም አቀፍ ደረጃ ደግሞ ሦስተኛው ቡና አምራችና ላኪ አገር የሚያደርጋት መሆኑንም አብራርተዋል።

ከቡና የሚገኘውን ገቢ ለማሻሻል የተከናወኑ የለውጥ ስራዎች ከዘርፉ የሚገኘው ገቢ እየጨመረ እንዲመጣ ማስቻሉን ጠቁመዋል።

4. በበጀት ዓመቱ 900 ቢሊዮን ብር ገቢ ተገኝቷል — ጠቅላይ ሚኒስትር ዐቢይ (ዶ/ር)

ጠቅላይ ሚኒስትር ዐቢይ አሕመድ (ዶ/ር) በዘንድሮ በጀት ዓመት 900 ቢሊዮን ብር ገቢ ተገኝቷል አሉ። ጠቅላይ ሚኒስትሩ ይህን የገለጹት የሕዝብ ተወካዮች ምክር ቤት እያካሄደ ባለው 42ኛ መደበኛ ስብሰባ ላይ ተገኝተው ከምክር ቤቱ አባላት ለተነሱላቸው ጥያቄዎች በሰጡት ምላሽና ማብራሪያ ነው።

በዚህም በዘንድሮ በጀት ዓመት 900 ቢሊዮን ብር ገቢ መገኘቱን አንስተው፣ አጠቃላይ ወጪው ደግሞ 1 ነጥብ 2 ትራሊየን ብር እንደሆነና የ300 ሚሊዮን ብር ልዩነት እንዳለው አመለክተዋል።

ገቢው ከአጠቃላይ ጥቅል ምርት አንጻር በጣም ዝቅተኛ መሆኑን ገልጸው፣ 46 ሺህ የሚጠጉ የታክስ ተመዝጋቢዎች ግብር እየከፈሉ አለመሆናቸውንም አብራርተዋል።

ከእነዚህም የሚሰበሰበው ገቢ ከአጠቃላይ 60 በመቶውን ብቻ የሚሸፍን እንደሆነና 40 በመቶው ገቢ ከተለያዩ ምንጮች እንደሚገኝ ተናግረዋል።

በመሆኑም ዘንድሮ 37 በመቶ ብቻ የሆነውን የግብር ከፋይ ቁጥር 50 በመቶ ማድረስ ከተቻለ ከታክስ የሚሰበሰበው ገቢ ይጨምራልም ነው ያሉት።

5. World Bank, IMF Approve Additional Financing for Macroeconomic Reforms

The World Bank has approved USD one billion in support of Ethiopia's ongoing macroeconomic reforms, according to officials at the Ministry of Finance. The approval was announced days after the International Monetary Fund (IMF) green lit an additional USD 262 million in financing following the third review of Ethiopia's performance under the Extended Credit Facility (ECF) program that began one year ago. It also follows reports that Ethiopia is on the verge of finalizing the terms of a drawn-out debt restructuring process.

The latest round of financing from the World Bank under the '*Ethiopia Second Sustainable and Inclusive Growth Development Policy Operation*' consists of grants and concessional credit, according to the Ministry.

"The program aims to bolster recent government efforts to ensure financial sector stability, enhance trade competitiveness, strengthen domestic resource mobilization, promote transparent and effective governance, and ensure the sustainability of social services," reads a statement from the Ministry.

6. Ethiopia Earns 2.6 billion USD from Coffee Exports in Concluded Fiscal Year

Ethiopia earned 2.6 billion USD from coffee exports in the just-concluded fiscal year, the Ethiopian Coffee and Tea Authority (ECTA) announced. Director General of the Authority, Adugna Debela, stated that the Authority had initially planned to export 326,000 tons of coffee and generate 2 billion USD in revenue. However, over 470,000 tons were exported, resulting in earnings of 2.65 billion USD. Adugna highlighted that this achievement makes Ethiopia the leading coffee exporter in Africa and the third-largest coffee producer and exporter globally.

He recalled that in the 2016 Ethiopian fiscal year, the country earned 1.4 billion USD from coffee exports.

The 2017 Ethiopian fiscal year's revenue thus represents an increase of 1.2 billion USD.

The Director General attributed this success to various reform measures implemented to boost income from the coffee sector.

7. ESX set to commence official trading next week, marking major financial milestone

Capital: July 6, 2025

Ethiopia's much-anticipated Securities Exchange (ESX) is poised to begin official trading next week, signaling a transformative moment for the country's financial sector. Following successful pilot transactions conducted two weeks ago, the ESX is now ready to fully operate, opening new avenues for investment and economic growth.

Since its establishment in October 2023, the ESX has garnered significant attention and support from both local and international investors. The capital raising campaign, launched in November 2023, exceeded expectations by securing 1.5 billion birr (approximately \$26.6 million), surpassing the initial target by an extraordinary 631%. This capital infusion came from 48 institutional investors across finance and non-financial sectors, with coordinated efforts spanning Addis Ababa, Nairobi, and London.

The ESX operates under a pioneering public-private partnership model, with the Ethiopian government holding a 25% stake through Ethiopian Investment Holdings, while the private sector controls the remaining 75%. Key foreign investors include FSD Africa, the Trade and Development Bank Group (TDB), and Nigeria's NGX Group. On the domestic front, participation comes from 16 private commercial banks, 12 private insurance companies, and 17 other institutional investors. State-owned enterprises such as Ethio Telecom and the Commercial Bank of Ethiopia also hold shares, collectively accounting for the government's stake.

8. New Investment Promotion Strategy Aims To Enhance Ethiopia's Economic Competitiveness

Ethiopia's newly drafted Investment Promotion Strategy (2025–2030) seeks to reposition the country's investment framework by identifying and prioritizing high-potential sectors to strengthen economic competitiveness, according to the Ethiopian Investment Commissioner.

A validation workshop on the strategy was held today in Addis Ababa, bringing together stakeholders from public institutions, development partners, and the private sector. Speaking at the event, Ethiopian Investment Commission (EIC) Commissioner Zeleke Temesgen said Ethiopia has undertaken significant reforms in recent years to improve the investment climate and attract quality investment. To ensure the success of these reforms, he noted, revising the country's investment promotion strategy has become essential.

"The new strategy is designed to reinforce institutional capacity, rebuild investor confidence, and promote sustainable, targeted investment," the Commissioner stated.
