6. Ethiopia's Agricultural Export Quality Measures Yield Successes, Confirms Authority

The Ethiopian Agricultural Authority has announced that its measures to ensure the quality and safety of agricultural products destined for foreign markets have yielded successful results.

Ambassador Diriba Kuma, Director General of the Authority, told ENA that rigorous inspections have been carried out on both imported and exported agricultural products to confirm they meet high-quality standards, properly registered, and fit for consumption.

These inspections also cover agricultural technologies, inputs, and related services, he added.

According to Ambassador Diriba, no quality issues were reported in the marketing of Ethiopia's agricultural exports during the concluded 2017 Ethiopian fiscal year as the authority inspected and monitored 877,350 tons of plants and plant products, 21,200 tons of meat and by-products, 621,000 live animals, and 270 tons of wax and honey products.

All inspections were conducted in compliance with international standards, a practice that has strengthened Ethiopia's market position abroad and boosted global demand for its products.

The Authority also oversees the use of fertilizers and chemicals in animal husbandry, floriculture, and crop farming

7. AfDB to Take Lead in USD 7.8bln Financing Mobilization Drive for Airport Megaproject

Ethiopian Airlines to finance 20 percent of costs out of pocket

The African Development Bank (AfDB) is set to lead efforts to raise USD 7.8 billion for the construction of a new international airport in Ethiopia, according to a formal announcement made this week.

A formal financing agreement between Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed (PhD) and AfDB outgoing President Akinwumi Adesina is scheduled to be signed on Monday, August 11, 2025. The deal will mark a major milestone in Ethiopia's longstanding efforts to build a new hub for its state-owned flag carrier, Ethiopian Airlines Group.

With the capacity to serve up to 100 million passengers annually, the Bishoftu International Airport slated for completion in three years is projected to become the largest on the continent.

The signing of the agreement would mark a major turning point in Ethiopia's most ambitious aviation infrastructure project to date and the announcement comes over a year after Ethiopian Airlines formally launched the project's design and financing process.

In August 2024, Ethiopian Airlines CEO Mesfin Tasew signed a design and consultancy contract with Dar Al-Handasah, a Beirut-based engineering firm.

8. Ethiopia Gazettes Provisional Tariff Concessions, Paving Way For AfCFTA Trade Benefits

Ethiopia has officially published its Provisional Schedule of Tariff Concessions (PSTCs) in the national gazette, a decisive move toward fully implementing the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) Agreement.

Gazetting the PSTCs makes the new tariff measures a matter of public record, ensuring transparency and enabling businesses, trade organizations, and the public to prepare for the changes, local news agency ENA reported, citing the nation's foreign ministry. The schedule sets out the specific tariff reductions Ethiopia will grant to eligible goods under the AfCFTA framework. The AfCFTA Secretariat, in a statement on social media, hailed the step as providing traders with "clarity and legal certainty" that Ethiopia will offer preferential tariff treatment in line with its commitments.

By formalizing its tariff concessions, Ethiopia joins a growing number of member states moving from policy commitments to operational measures designed to expand intra-African trade, lower tariff barriers, and advance the continent's economic integration agenda.

The AfCFTA is a flagship initiative of the African Union's Agenda 2063.
