5. NBE holds interest rate at 15%, eases credit cap to 24%

The National Bank of Ethiopia (NBE) has decided to hold its key interest rate steady at 15 percent while easing the credit growth ceiling to 24 percent for the 2025/26 fiscal year. This decision was announced following the fourth meeting of the NBE's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) on September 25, 2025

The MPC, tasked with guiding the country's monetary policy under Proclamation No. 1359/2025, opted to maintain a prudent stance aimed at continuing the reduction of inflation. While the base rate remains unchanged, the credit growth limit has been raised from 18 percent to 24 percent, a move approved by the NBE Board after the MPC's recommendation.

The committee emphasized that increasing the credit ceiling at this time is a cautious but necessary step to support financial stability and sustain the gains made in curbing inflation. Other monetary policy tools and requirements for financial institutions, including reserve requirements, were kept unchanged.

The NBE further indicated its readiness to employ a full range of market-based instruments, including open market operations and foreign exchange interventions, to manage monetary conditions effectively. The next MPC meeting is scheduled for December 2025.

6. Ethiopian Airlines to Establish 'Special Purpose Company' for Bishoftu Airport Project

The Ethiopian Airlines Group has unveiled detailed plans to establish a Special Purpose Company (SPC) to develop, finance, and operate its landmark Bishoftu International Airport (BIA) project.

The subsidiary company to be placed in charge of the USD 10 billion megaproject will be fully owned by the Group. Its executives are eager to see construction begin on the extension for Addis Ababa's Bole International Airport, which they hope will serve as a springboard for Ethiopia's long-term aviation ambitions.

The detailed plans pertaining to the structure, development, financing and operations of BIA were disclosed during a two-day stakeholder showcase in Addis Ababa that gathered more than 40 institutions, including development banks, contractors, and financiers.

7. Ethiopia's Reforms Pave The Way For Sustainable And Inclusive Growth: Macroeconomic Adviser

Ethiopia's sweeping macroeconomic reforms are setting the stage for a new chapter of sustainable, diversified, and inclusive growth, according to Ambassador Girma Biru, Macroeconomic Advisor to the Prime Minister.

Ambassador Girma underscored that the reform package—designed to modernize the economy, sharpen competitiveness, and expand investment opportunities—is already delivering measurable progress across agriculture, manufacturing, and services. Productivity gains, greater sectoral resilience, and broader private-sector engagement are emerging as defining outcomes.

“By moving toward a more market-oriented economic framework, we are unlocking the potential of sectors long underutilized, enabling them to become central drivers of national development,” Ambassador Girma remarked.

A central pillar of the reform agenda is the liberalization of the foreign exchange regime, which now allows the Ethiopian birr to be determined by market dynamics. This structural shift, he noted, has bolstered export competitiveness, attracted foreign currency inflows, and strengthened profitability for domestic producers. Early signs include a narrowing trade deficit as export volumes rise and foreign direct investment accelerates.

8. Ethiopia's Natural Gas, Fertilizer Plants to Drive Trillion-Dollar Economy by 2040: Prominent Investment Advisor

A prominent investment advisor and businessman described the 2.5 billion USD urea fertilizer complex deal between Ethiopia and Dangote Industries Limited, forecasting economic transformation as the investment eliminates billions of dollars in fertilizer imports.

Ethiopia is positioned for unprecedented economic growth as the production of natural gas and massive fertilizer facilities converge to transform the East African nation into a continental industrial powerhouse, Zemedeneh Nigatu, CBE Capital Investment Bank CEO and a seasoned Ethiopian-American investment advisor said.

The country's emergence as a natural gas producer, combined with upcoming fertilizer plants will replace billions in annual import expenditure, representing a fundamental shift in Ethiopia's economic trajectory from resource dependency to industrial self-sufficiency and export capacity.

The recent announcement of substantial natural gas reserves in the Kalub and Hilala fields represents a game-changing development for Ethiopia's industrial ambitions.
