5. Ministry Urges Exporters to Harness AfCFTA Opportunities

The Ministry of Trade and Regional Integration has called on the export sector to take full advantage of the opportunities created by the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) to achieve stronger export performance.

Samuel Gizaw, AfCFTA Desk Coordinator at the Ministry, told ENA that the implementation of the agreement presents a vast market potential, given Africa's large population and growing annual GDP.

He emphasized that the business community and other stakeholders should actively seize these opportunities.

Samuel noted that the AfCFTA is not only aimed at reducing tariffs but also at simplifying complex trade procedures, which will enhance competitiveness in the continental market.

"The agreement will help our exporters become more competitive and increase export trade at a rapid pace," he said, urging businesses to prepare to make the most of the new market opportunities.

Exporters have also confirmed that the implementation of the agreement has already had a positive impact by expanding destination markets and increasing competitiveness in African markets.

Khalifa Hussein, Chairman of the Board of the Ethiopian Meat Producers and Exporters Association, told ENA that the launch of the AfCFTA will provide vast market opportunities across African countries.

6. Ethiopia And Viet Nam Strengthen Trade, Investment, And WTO Collaboration

Ethiopia and Viet Nam held constructive talks today to advance Ethiopia's accession to the World Trade Organization (WTO) and further strengthen bilateral trade and investment relations.

The Permanent Representative of Ethiopia to the United Nations Office at Geneva and other international organizations, Tsegab Kebebew, met with Viet Nam's Permanent Representative to the UN, WTO, and other international organizations, Mai Phan Dung, to discuss issues of mutual interest within the framework of Ethiopia's WTO accession.

Both sides welcomed the positive momentum in bilateral market access negotiations, with Tsegab emphasizing Ethiopia's readiness to finalize discussions by the end of November 2025

7. Regulators Seek to Bar Sub-Investment-Grade Banks from Entering Ethiopian Market

Foreign banks seeking to operate through subsidiaries in Ethiopia will be admitted only if they hold an investment grade credit rating of at least BBB- or its equivalent, according to a directive in the making at the National Bank of Ethiopia (NBE).

The draft 'Requirements for Licensing and Renewal of Banking Business and Representative Office Directive' seeks to set entry standards for foreign entrants and marks the first time that Ethiopia has made an external credit-rating threshold a statutory prerequisite for market access.

The draft requires any foreign bank wishing to establish a subsidiary, branch or representative office to submit a formal "no-objection letter" from its home supervisory authority directly to the NBE.

An assurance from the Bank's home supervisory authority is also expected to confirm the applicant is in good financial standing, maintains the home supervisor's risk management standards, meets prudential requirements and has been rated investment grade, "that is, at least BBB- or BAA or equivalent, by rating agencies such as Standard & Poor's, Fitch or Moody's."

8. Ethiopian Company Launches Affordable Solar Stove to Boost Clean Cooking Access

EBC: Nov 5, 2025 Green Scene Energy Plc has introduced "Tolo," a new line of locally manufactured solar-powered cooking stoves, aimed at making clean cooking more accessible, especially in off-grid rural areas of Ethiopia. The Tolo stove is priced significantly below market competitors, costing 25–30 percent less than similar infrared stoves. Designed to operate on solar energy via Direct Current Charging (DCC), the stove can function both on and off the national grid, offering a clean, efficient alternative to traditional biomass and charcoal cooking methods. "Tolo is designed for households that lack electricity as well as users seeking cleaner and more efficient alternatives," said Rekike Bekele, CEO of Green Scene Energy. The company, founded in 2016, is producing the stoves **at its factory in Addis Ababa, with a capacity of over 200 units daily. Green Scene Energy plans to distribute the Tolo stoves through a flexible pay-as-you-go model via micro finance institutions and local retailers Clean Cooking Programme (2035).**
